#### Kindergarten School Supply List 2025-2026

To help ensure a successful and comfortable learning environment for all our kindergarteners, we kindly request the following supplies for the upcoming school year. Please label all items with your child's first and last name unless otherwise noted.

#### **Individual Student Supplies:**

- Backpack: Large enough to fit a folder and lunchbox.
- Lunchbox/Bag: If your child will be bringing lunch from home.
- Water Bottle: Reusable, spill-proof, and clearly labeled.
- Crayola Crayons: 2 boxes of 24 count (Crayola brand works best).
- Glue Sticks: 6-8 large glue sticks.
- Safety "Blunt-Tip" Scissors: 1 pair (child-safe).
- #2 Pencils: 1 dozen sharpened.
- Dry Erase Markers: 4 black, chisel tip with an old sock or microfiber cloth for an eraser
- Pink Erasers: 2 large (e.g., block and cap erasers).
- Plastic Pencil Box/Pouch: To hold crayons, glue sticks, and scissors.
- **Headphones (not earbuds):** Over-the-ear style, comfortable for your child. Please label these clearly.
- Change of Clothes: A full set of weather-appropriate clothes (shirt, pants, underwear, socks) in a Ziploc bag, labeled with your child's name. This will stay at school in case of spills or accidents.

### Classroom Community Supplies (No Need to Label These):

- Gallon-sized Ziploc Bags: 1 box.
- Quart-sized Ziploc Bags: 1 box.
- Baby Wipes: 1 large container (for quick clean-ups).
- Tissues: 2 large boxes.
- Paper Towels: 1 roll.
- Hand Sanitizer: 1 large bottle (with pump).
